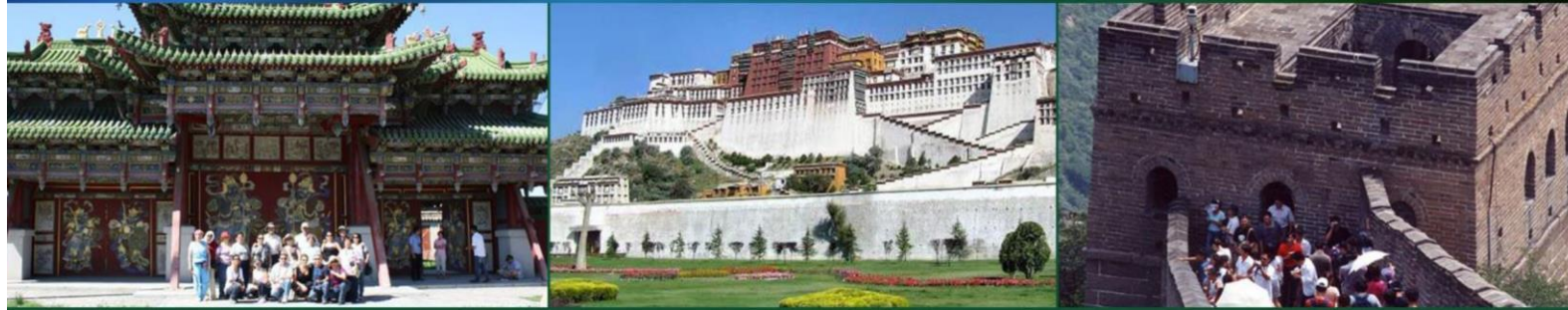

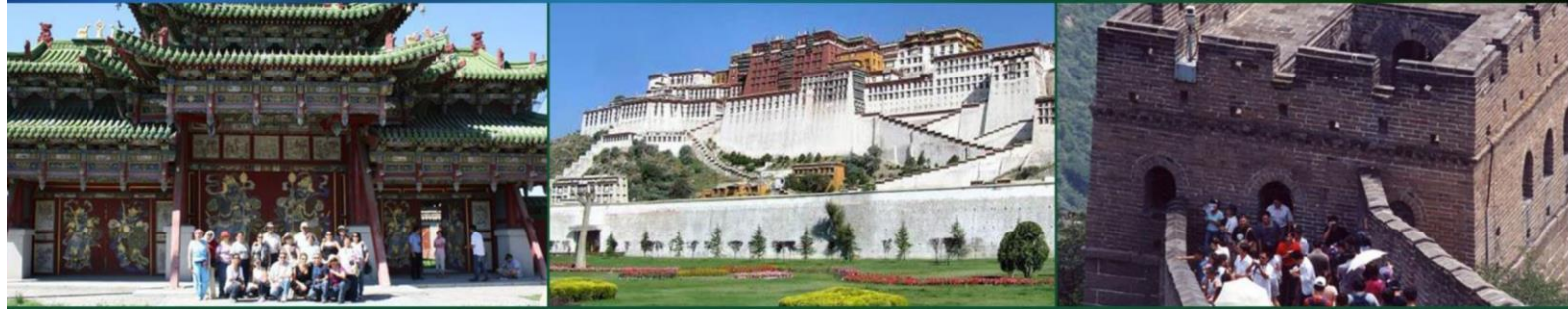

**TUESDAY, SATURDAY, Day 01**-Upon your arrival in **Ulaanbaatar Genghis Khan New Airport** (**excluding flights**, 52kms/32.32miles, +2hours driving). Meet **Samar Magic Tours Team** and transfer to hotel (\*by hotels policy the check-in time is after **02:00PM/14:00**). Overnight at Holiday Inn hotel 5\* or Blue Sky & Tower hotel 5\* or at Top Shangri-La hotel 5\* or similar.



**WEDNESDAY, SUNDAY, Day 02-Ulaanbaatar City tour:** Visit the **Gandantegchinlen Monastery** is a Tibetan-style Buddhist monastery that has been restored and revitalized since 1990. The Tibetan name translates to the "Great Place of Complete Joy". It currently has over 150 monks in residence. It features a 26.5-meter-high statue of Avalokitesvara. It came under state protection in 1994. Here you will have the opportunity to attend a Buddhist ceremony, **small dinosaur's fossils museum**, and the **National History Museum**-where you will see artefacts from Mongolia and Central Asia from the Stone Age to the present and the Sukh Baatar square-this is the main square in the heart of Ulaanbaatar. Here you will see a large statue of the Genghis Khan-inaugurated in 2006 on the occasion of 800th Anniversary of the Great Mongolian Empire of Genghis Khan (1206-2006), the Sukh Baatar Hero along with The Parliament House, Stock Exchange, the Drama Theatre and the Palace of Culture. **Welcome Lunch in Traditional Local Restaurant.** **05:00PM-Enjoy the Mongolian Performers** (concert which includes the Tsam dance, traditional Mongolian singers, dancers, Tuvan throat singing and



contortionists). Overnight at Holiday Inn hotel 5\* or Blue Sky & Tower hotel 5\* or at Top Shangri-La hotel 5\* or similar. **(B)(L)**



**THURSDAY, MONDAY, Day 03:** Breakfast. Transfer to Ulaanbaatar Genghis Khan New Airport (52kms/32.32miles, +2hours driving). Take your **domestic flight Ulaanbaatar/Gobi Desert** (about 1.30-1.50 hrs). Upon your arrival in Gobi Desert Local Airport, meet our transport (arrive from Ulaanbaatar in 1-2 days before) and to be transferred. Drive towards to **Yolin Am Canyon or Valley of Vultures in the Gobi Gurvansaikhan National Park**, was established in 1993, and expanded to its current size in 2000. This the largest national park in Mongolia. Here, you will have the opportunity for hiking in the ice valley of Gobi, the stunning landscapes. There is a small museum, which displays dinosaur eggs, some bones and stuffed birds and leopards. **Explore the area on foot.** Overnight in Gobi Nomad Lodge or similar. **(B)(L)(D)**

**FRIDAY, TUESDAY, Day 04:** Breakfast. Drive towards to reach **Moltsog sand dunes**. Exploration and enjoy and climb up to the sand dunes. **Visit an authentic camel breeding family** and ride two humped Bactrian camels. See their real nomadic life. Afterward, drive back to **Bayanzag (Rich in Saxual) or Flaming Cliffs** in Gobi Desert. Explore Bayanzag (Rich in Saxual) or Flaming Cliffs-here Roy Chapman Andrews, an American palaeontologist and staff of the Museum of Natural History in New York first found 4-6 inches dinosaur eggs here in 1922. The large dinosaur skeletons placed at the Museum of Natural History in Ulaanbaatar was also found here by a Russian-Mongolian expedition. Bayanzag is referred as Flaming Cliffs for its



amazing colours and shape). Enjoy the Gobi sunset at the legendary "Flaming Cliffs," which glow brilliantly at sunrise and sunset. Overnight in Gobi Nomad Lodge or similar. **(B)(L)(D)**



**SATURDAY, WEDNESDAY, Day 05:** Breakfast. Transfer to Gobi local airport and take your flight Gobi Desert/Ulaanbaatar (about. 1.30-1.50 hrs). Upon your arrival in **Ulaanbaatar Genghis Khan New Airport (excluding flights, 52kms/32.32miles, +2hours driving)**. Meet **Samar Magic Tours Team** and drive directly further north to reach **Gorkhi/Terelj National Park**. Seeing grasslands and beautiful vistas. The valley is about 20kms/12miles long at 1600m. This picturesque National Park is a part of Khan Khentii Strictly Protected Area. It is a great place for hiking, trekking, even you can rock climb here at its natural steep granite walls. Explore the **Turtle shaped**

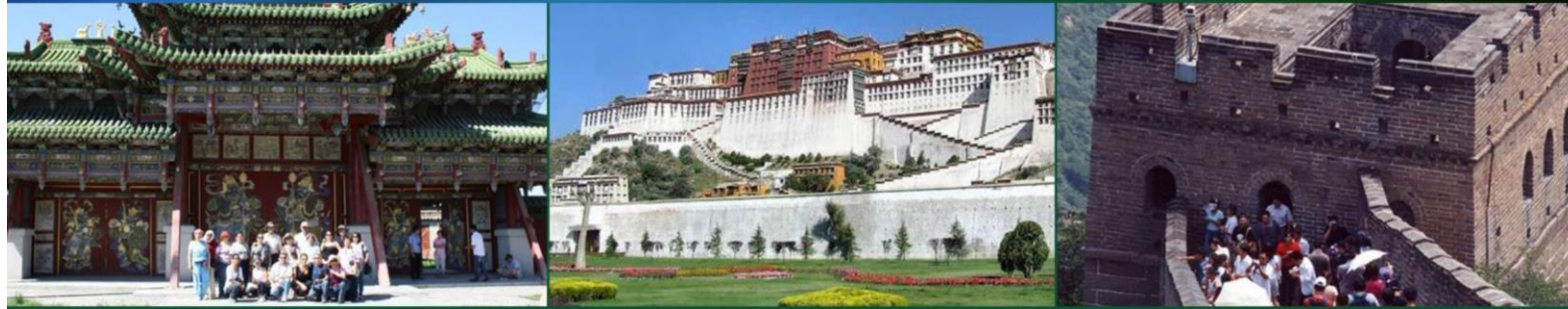


**original giant rock** - symbol of Gorkhi/Terelj. Walking & Easy Trekking to **Arryabal Meditation Temple**, on the top of the small hill. Overnight in Terelj Mountain Lodge or similar. **(B)(L)(D)**



**SUNDAY, THURSDAY, Day 06:** Breakfast. Next, drive towards to visit the **40 meter /~133,3 feet Genghis Khan Statue on horseback** (50km/31.1miles). The statue is symbolically pointed east towards his birthplace. It is on top of the Genghis Khan Statue Complex, a visitor center, itself 10 meters (32 ft 10 in) tall, with 36 columns representing the 36 khans from Genghis to Ligdan Khan. Visitors walk to the head of the horse through its chest and neck of the horse, where they can have a panoramic view. **Drive back to Ulaanbaatar city** (55km/34.2miles). **Lunch is included in local restaurant in Ulaanbaatar.** Transfer to the hotel (\*by hotels policy the check-in time is after **02:00PM/14:00**). Next, visit the **New Museum "Genghis Kan" ("Chinggis Khaan")**, finally opened in **Octubre 11-2022**. The museum is designed to show the history of the Mongol kings from the reign of King Hunnu Modun Shanyu

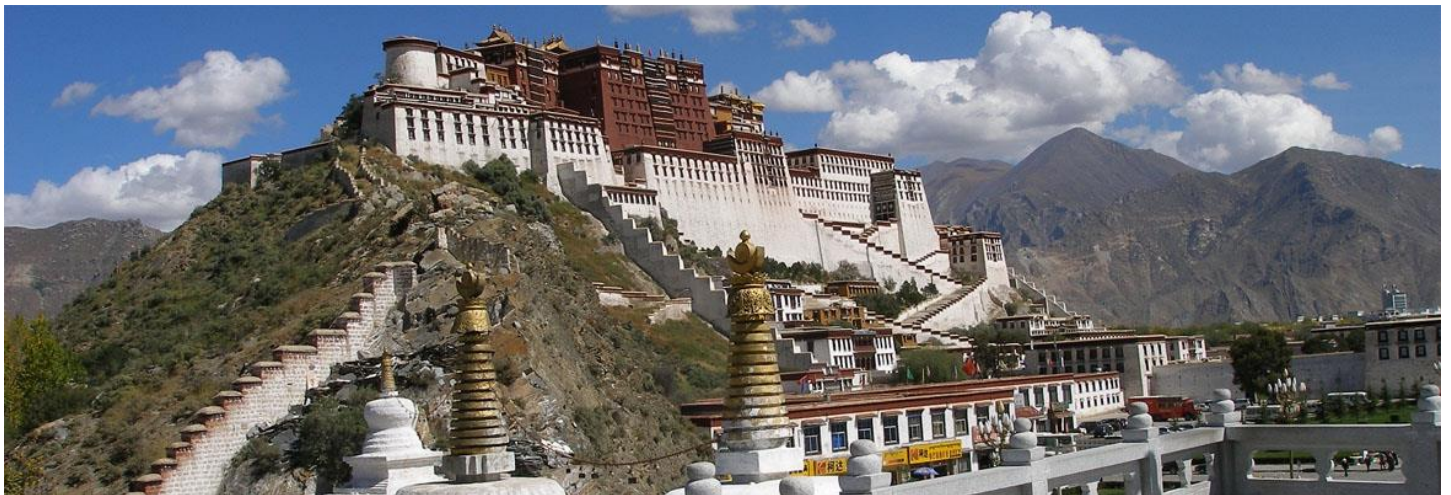




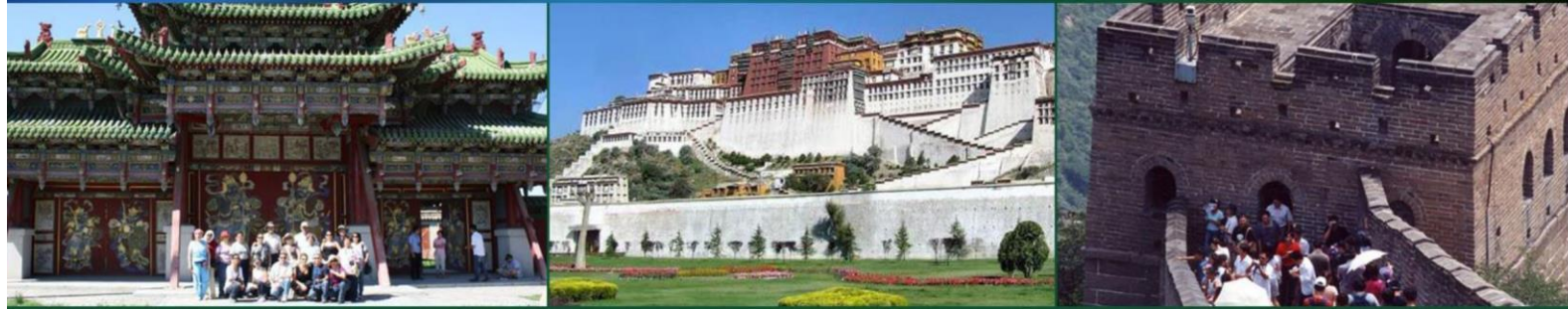

**TUESDAY, SATURDAY, Day 08: Flight from Beijing to Lhasa.** Arrive in **Lhasa, capital of Tibet.** It is the second most populous city on the Tibetan Plateau after Xining and, at an altitude of 3,490 metres (11,450 ft), Lhasa is one of the highest cities in the world. **Free time at hotel.** Overnight at Lhasa Tse Dang hotel (equivalent 4\*) / Thangka hotel (equivalent 4\*) / Lhasa Gang-Gyan hotel (equivalent 4\*) / Lhasa Tashi Norta hotel (equivalent 4\*). **(B)**



**WEDNESDAY, SUNDAY, Day 09: LHASA:** Today, we visit **the Potala Palace**, was the chief residence of the **Dalai Lama** until the **14th Dalai Lama** fled to India during the 1959 Tibetan uprising. It is now a museum and **UNESCO World Heritage Site.** Visit **Sera Monastery**-is one of the great three Gelukpa university monasteries of Tibet, located 1.25 miles (2.01 km) north of Lhasa. The **Sera Monastery**, as a complex of structures with the Great Assembly Hall and three colleges, was founded in 1419 by Jamchen Choje of Sakya Yeshe of Zel Gungtang (1355 -1435), a disciple of Tsongkhapa. Overnight at Lhasa Tse Dang hotel (equivalent 4\*) / Thangka hotel (equivalent 4\*) / Lhasa Gang-Gyan hotel (equivalent 4\*) / Lhasa Tashi Norta hotel (equivalent 4\*). **(B)(A)**



**THURSDAY, MONDAY, Day 10: LHASA:** Breakfast. Today, we visit the **Jokhang Monastery or Zuglagkang**, is located on **Barkhor Square** in Lhasa. For most Tibetans it is the most sacred and important temple in Tibet. It is in some regards pan-sectarian, but is controlled by the Gelug school. The temple's architectural style is a mixture of Indian vihara design, Chinese Tang Dynasty design, and Nepalese design. Afterward, we visit the **Barkhor market** (the Tromzikhang market) is busy in Barkhor, and the area is a major tourist attraction. Afterward, we visit **Norbulingka Palace**-is a palace and surrounding park in Lhasa, Tibet, built from 1755. It served as the traditional summer residence of the successive Dalai Lamas from the 1780s up until the 14th Dalai Lama's exile in 1959. Part of the "Historic Ensemble of the Potala Palace", Norbulingka is recognized as a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**, and was added as an extension of this Historic Ensemble in 2001. It was built by the 7th Dalai Lama and served both as administrative centre and religious centre. It is a unique representation of Tibetan palace architecture. **Norbulingka Palace** is situated in the west side of Lhasa, a short distance to the southwest of Potala Palace. Norbulingka covers an area of around 36 hectares (89 acres) and considered to be the largest man-made garden in Tibet. Overnight at Lhasa Tse Dang hotel (equivalent 4\*) / Thangka hotel (equivalent 4\*) / Lhasa Gang-Gyan hotel (equivalent 4\*) / Lhasa Tashi Norta hotel (equivalent 4\*). **(B)(A)**

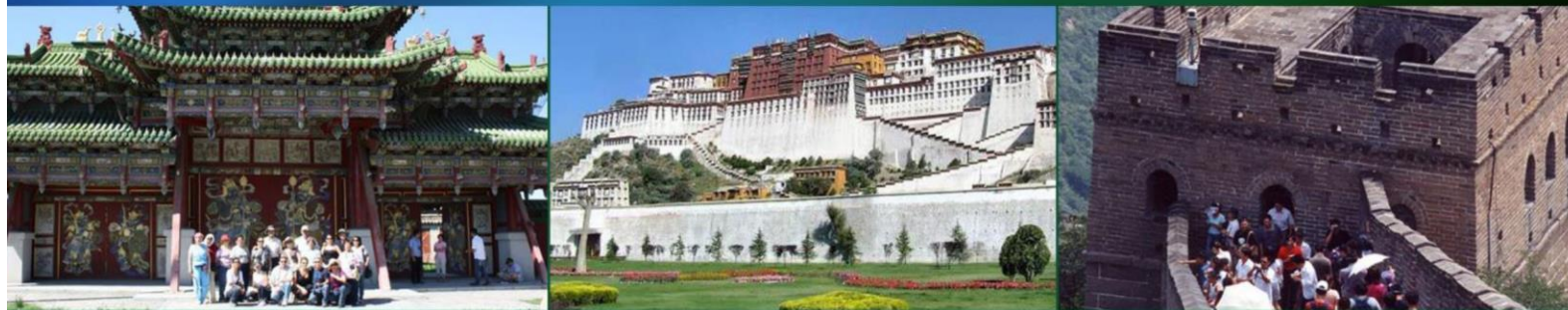

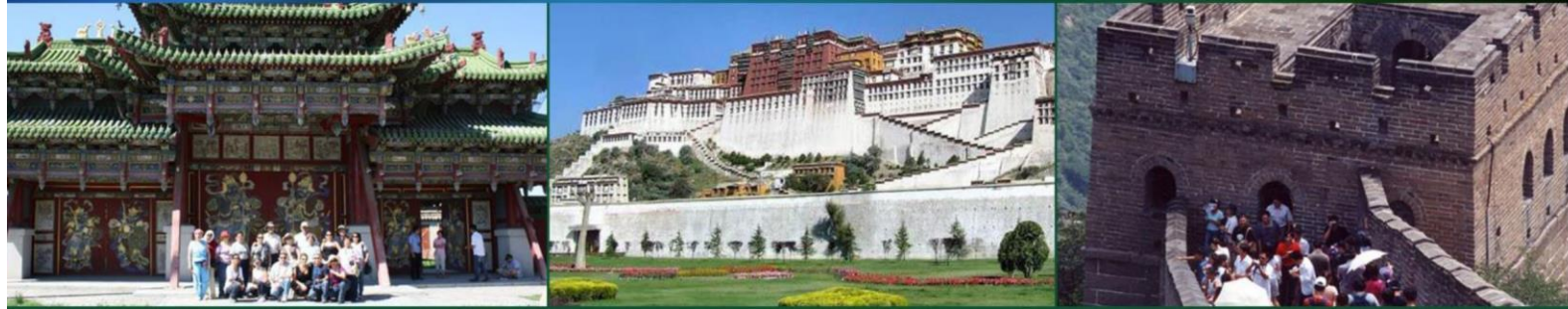
